**Creating Team Norms**

- Successful committees and their attributes
  - Outcomes-driven, regular reporting of activities, committee output moves through several stages internally and externally
  - Clear objects that can be quantified
  - Ongoing communication with members: agendas, minutes, etc.
  - Open communication among members
  - Communication between faculty and administration members on the committee
  - Members take initiative to be prepared in advance of meetings
  - Provide members with a greater understanding of the college and its processes – “why we do the things we do”
  - Diversity of perspective, and acting upon that
  - The act of compromise is valued
  - Have clear goals so members can celebrate milestones along the journey
  - Data-driven
  - Leadership support so that committee work is valued and isn’t for naught
- **Unsuccessful committees and their attributes**
  - No clear mission statement, objective, and/or leadership
  - Failure to prioritize students and their needs over those of faculty and staff
