Armando Lerma solo exhibition presents a series of paintings fusing past cultural (ancient) civilizations with Pop Culture. Often sending the mundane down a spiritual path, by informing the viewer with references to Pop Culture, mythology, Coachella Vallery landscape and Chicano iconography. Lerma elevates mundane objects and their functionality to a place of intrigue. His appropriation of old signage mixed in with original works

bends space and time, weaving the past with the present, and creating a multidimensional reflection of commercialized brands, spray-painted over, and infused with his visual vocabulary, often transporting his audience.
