3.1 Vision Resource Center			
DISCUSSION	<p>Donna Greene discussed the Cornerstone Program that the district is adopting from the Chancellor’s Office. They are introducing the Vision Resource Center, a new portal dedicated to providing the support needed to meet the goals and commitments of the Vision for Success through the Guided Pathways framework. She feels this portal can serve the purpose of what this committee has been discussing—a portal to engage resources and communication.</p> <p>Through the Vision Resource Center, it will be tied to our portal and will be a communication and training portal for COD faculty, staff and administrators.</p> <p>You can view the Vision Resource Center and Palomar College professional development portals for ideas on how we can customize and brand our own website. The Chancellor’s Office Foundation is paying for the initial implementation and the service maintenance for three years. Target date for implementation is fall 2019.</p> <p>Discussion ensued on ideas of what we would like to see on our portal. We could use it for communication, professional development, notice of events, etc.</p>

DISCUSSION	<p>Christine Schaefer asked if it is possible to have Zoom conferencing capabilities in the classroom. Zoom is a web-based conferencing tool that can be used to host meetings, record sessions, collaborate on projects, training purposes, etc.</p> <p>Donna responded that a computer microphone and webcam are required to allow the interaction on Zoom.</p> <p>Donna mentioned that at a senate meeting yesterday, library staff expressed that they feel under-resourced.</p> <p>Paulina Rodriguez shared that she just returned from a conference where she learned how College of the Canyons is implementing one of their strategies in Pillar III—Staying on the Path. They are requiring all of their athletes to spend 30 hours a semester in their student center or library to work on their coursework. They are keeping track of their hours by using their ID cards to scan when they enter and leave the facility.</p>
