B) New Program

1. **CHILD AND ADOLESCENT DEVELOPMENT A.A. for Transfer Degree (AA-T)**

The Child and Adolescent Development Degree is designed to prepare students to transfer to CSU or UC to complete a bachelor's degree in Child and Adolescent Development. This major is an interdisciplinary program of study of the processes of change and growth that characterize human development. Course offerings are drawn from psychology, sociology, human development, anthropology, and biology, with electives from other departments. Students completing an Associate's Degree in Child and Adolescent Development are qualified to work in school districts as classroom paraprofessionals and for social services programs as entry level social workers. Students completing a Bachelor of Arts degree in this major typically choose careers in education, social services, counseling, and guidance or in the field of health.

Graduates with a child and adolescent development degree typically work as social workers, educational paraprofessionals, social services, counseling and guidance or health fields.
