## TEXTBOOK ADOPTION

- 1. Textbooks and other instructional materials for the course outline of record (COR) will be recommended for adoption by full-time faculty in a subject area for approval. In the absence of a full-time faculty member in a subject area, the Dean will obtain any necessary information from part-time faculty members or from other sources before making any recommendations.
- 2. Except as authorized in designated courses, a standard textbook(s) should be adopted for each course COR.
- 3. For multi-section courses, an alternative text(s) may be recommended for adoption by faculty in the subject area. Except in cases where articulation, licensing, or transfer requirements stipulate that a particular textbook must be used, faculty may choose an equivalent alternative textbook that aligns with the COR. Decisions regarding the equivalency and COR alignment of an alternative textbook will be made in consultation with full-time faculty and part-time faculty members who have expertise in the subject area.
- 4. When possible, all textbooks will be ordered through the college bookstore.
