

## **COMMUNITY SERVICES PROGRAMS**

In addition to credit and non-credit coursework as defined by the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office, the Board of Trustees authorizes appropriate College offices to offer not-for-credit classes based on emerging needs of business and the general community without Board approval.

Offerings may be established and maintained in civic, vocational, literacy, health, family and consumer sciences, technical and general education, including, but not limited to, classes in the fields of music, drama, art, handicraft, science, literature, nature study, nature contacting, aquatic sports and athletics.

Offerings are designed to provide instruction and to contribute to the physical, mental, moral, economic, or civic development of the individuals or groups enrolled in them.

Offerings are open for the admission of adults and of those minors as in the judgment of the governing board may profit. Offerings are primarily focused on professional development and personal enrichment.

General fund monies are not expended to establish and maintain community services offerings.

Students enrolled in community services offerings may be charged a fee not to exceed the cost of maintaining community services classes, or classes may be provided for remuneration by contract, or with contributions or donations of individuals or groups.
