EMERITUS STATUS

The Board of Trustees directs the Superintendent/President to establish procedures to confer the title of Emeritus upon any retiring administrator or classified/confidential employee who has given honorable and distinguished service to the College.

The Board of Trustees reserves the right to remove the title of Emeritus in certain circumstances where it deems damage may be caused to the reputation of the College by having a continued association with the person.

Conferral of the title of Emeritus upon any retiring faculty member is the purview of Academic Senate in accordance with the procedures outlined in Academic Senate Resolution 1.45.01, subject to the final approval of the Board of Trustees.

Conferral of the title of Emeritus upon any retiring trustee is the purview of the Board of Trustees.
