PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

The Desert Community College District will ensure that applicants, employees, and students with disabilities receive reasonable accommodations consistent with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act, Government Code Sections 11135, et seq., and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. Anyone with a physical or mental impairment substantially limiting one or more major life activities; has a record of such impairment; or is regarded as having such impairment; is considered a person with a disability. Major life activities means functions such as caring for one's self, performing manual tasks, walking, seeing, hearing, speaking, breathing, learning and working.
