## Checklist for Reviewing Student Learning Outcomes

The outcome states what students can do based on the
successful completion of the course.
The outcome is measurable. Evidence gathered through an
activity, group project, assignment, test, presentation, or
paper that indicates to what degree the student can perform
the outcome.
Each outcome describes one ability the student can
demonstrate.
The outcome is specifically tied to the course description
focusing on the central aspects that are the most meaningful
and important.
The outcome is appropriate to the level of expertise the
student should be at for a career or the associate's level of
the discipline.
The outcome is specific to the course and could not describe
any other course.
