Transfer Student:

Complete the online orientation which is accessible from your MyCod Portal account. The Counseling Center will then activate your records for registration. You will need to see a counselor with your transcripts (unofficial or printed from a website acceptable for advising and registration clearance) that demonstrate clear proof you have met the prerequisite to a course you wish to enroll in at College of the Desert.

Communications:

All communication from College of the Desert will now be sent to your official MyCod email address! You may login to your MyCod email and set up your account using the information above. First-time users, or former students who have not logged in to Microsoft 365, will be required to set up their password recovery upon logging in for the first time.

Register for Classes:

Once you have logged into your MyCod.us email account, complete ALL the next steps below in order to register for classes.

Online Orientation:

Open MyCod Student Portal and login with your MyCod username and password. Click on "Take the Student Orientation." You must complete this step to be cleared for registration.

My First Schedule Workshop:

Watch the My First Schedule Workshop Video to learn more about the registration process, get an idea of what classes to take, and learn more about the requirements for different degrees offered at COD!

Registration:

You will be able to register for classes via Self Service once you complete the first two steps. Each student will register on different dates and times based on units earned and/or special program participation. You will be able to see your specific registration date and time pop-out in the message bar as you register in Self Service.

Financial Aid:

In order to receive financial aid, including student programs offered at COD (i.e., pLEDGE, EOPS, TRiO ACES), students are required to submit a FAFSA or CA Dream Act Application. Be sure to add school code 001182 to your application so we can match you to financial aid as applicable.
