The following funds will be used for the 2019-2020 academic year. 1. \$45,000 for stipends that will allow 65 faculty members to participate in this initiative. 2. \$5,000 for the creation of student and faculty resources. 3. \$1,000 to conduct training and host meetings. 4. \$4,000 for website and video creation.

Collected data will be analyzed to calculate cost savings for students, measure the number of faculty involved, estimate the number of students affected, and count the number of courses where OERs were offered as a part of this initiative. Evaluations will occur at the end of the academic term to collect a) responses regarding faculty experiences adopting an OER textbook and b) explanations as to why a faculty member chose to continue with or cease requiring low cost/free textbooks.
