Classes

The IEA offers small class size with 15 students maximum per class. Students are placed into IEA classes based on an initial placement test that is taken during orientation.

3 Levels of Study: The IEA has 3 levels of study - Beginning*, Intermediate and Advanced. *Applicants should be able to read and write the English alphabet and to speak and respond to simple questions in English. Each level requires 16 weeks of study to advance to the next level; however, students can complete one level in the 8 week Summer Accelerated Program.



The IEA offers a Standard Program throughout the year and a Summer Accelerated Program during the summer session.

The Standard Program includes 30 hours per week of instruction including:

25 hours of classroom instruction:

- · Oral Communication
- Writing
- Grammar
- Reading
- Conversation

5 hours in the Language Lab

The 8 Week Summer Accelerated Program includes

32 hours per week of instruction including:

27 hours of classroom instruction:

- · Oral Communication
- Writing
- Grammar
- Reading

2 hours in the Language Lab and 3 hours of 'at home' study

IEA students use the Language Lab at College of the Desert as a part of their studies. The Language Lab offers the latest programs and technology for English instruction assistance.

Entering College of the Desert


Students who complete Level 3 at the IEA can enter College of the Desert without the TOEFL!
