1. Call to Order/Roll Call

Meeting was called to order at 8:04 am

2. Group Discussion Items

2.1 College of the Desert Operational Updates – Jeff Baker reported

- a. Vaccination Mandate
 - Dual enrollments will be minimally impacted by the mandate and will follow high school protocol
 - Concurrent enrollments will need to follow the mandate starting January 31, 2022
- b. Course Sizes
 - Currently 95% online, 10-15% hybrid, 50% class size cap
 - Moving back to original course class sizes in spring 2022
- c. Opening
 - January 3rd all entrances to College will be open
 - Student Support Services – check the COD website for updated information on hours of operation for [In-Person Student Services Available](#)

2.2 Retention and Reengagement Grant – Katie Chartier and Oscar Espinoza-Parra reported

- Indio event tonight, December 10th from 4:00 – 7:00 pm
- Counselors will be available to help students with course selection
- Lab set up for students to physically register and receive financial aid formation/assistance
- Flyers will be distributed, (see attached)
- ESLN events happening next month

2.3 Dual Enrollment – Brian Thompson presented

- High School Dual-Concurrent enrollment process has been streamlined by using [online web form](#) found on the COD website under [Admissions/High School Concurrent Enrollment](#)
- Paper enrollment forms are also accepted
- If student applies for the same course in both winter intersession and spring, the application that is received first will dictate which session the student is enrolled in.
- Dean Phillips reminded the committee that the window of time for students to withdraw for intersession is very short
- Deanna Keuilian asked about the timing of receiving student transcripts – Mr. Thompson will work with her to align the schedule

2.4 IGETC Certification Plan for High School Students – Amanda Phillips presented

- Dean Phillips shared some examples, attached, of the IGETC and CSUG certification
- IGETC is easier to obtain because it requires fewer classes
- CSUG is only for CSU students
- The examples provided are not the only courses that qualify. Custom courses can be created depending on minimum qualification requirements. Contact Dean Phillips for more information, afphillips@collegeofthedesert.edu.
- It is possible for high-achieving high school students to earn an associate's degree by adding summer school courses to the IGETC plan
