students per semester and hundreds of
faculty, staff and visitors spread across four
campuses in the Coachella Valley: Palm
Desert, East Valley Indio, West Valley Palm
Springs, and the Mecca Thermal campuses.

The Public Safety Department currently staffs Palm Desert, East Valley, West Valley and Mecca Thermal campuses with 34 Public Safety Officers of diverse backgrounds and education levels. Officers patrol the Palm Desert Campus 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and officers are present at all other campuses while classes are in session.

College of the Desert's Public Safety Academy has graduated the majority of the officers on duty and have over 300 hours of training from California Police Officer Standards and Training. Officers receive continuing education, recertifications and community CERT Trainings throughout the year.


