 - Indio High School


HOW TO APPLY TO UPWARD BOUND

Fill out an application form (may be attached, from your counselor or print the one on-line: www.collegeofthedesert.edu/ub)

- **The application includes the following sections:**
 - The application itself
 - A place for you to tell us about yourself
 - Recommendation form to be filled out by a Teacher, Counselor or Principal
- **Attach the following to your application:**
 - Current School Grade Transcripts (Report Card for 8th graders)
 - A <u>handwritten</u> essay telling us about an event that impacted you
- **String original document(s) to Upward Bound office to verify eligibility:**
 - Parent(s) latest Federal Income Tax Return
 - Student's Birth Certificate or U.S. Permanent Residency Card
 - Student's Social Security Card

- ❖ UPWARD BOUND provides tutoring, instruction, counseling, career information, motivation, and the opportunity to experience a college atmosphere while still in high school.
- UPWARD BOUND concentrates on these basic areas: Reading, Study Skills, English, Mathematics, and Science.

UPWARD BOUND PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The Academic Year Component includes:

- Saturday instructional sessions
- ❖ Academic tutoring
- ❖ Academic advising and career exploration
- Assistance in preparing for college entrance exams
- Assistance in completing college admissions applications
- Guidance in scholarships and financial aid
- College tours and cultural activities
- Calculator Loan Program
- Lunch provided

The Summer Component includes:

- Possible high school and college credit offerings
- ❖ A six-week summer program
- * Extensive tutoring and counseling
- Supplemental instruction and project based courses
- Summer mentorship program
- College tours and cultural activities
- Summer residential program for eligible students.
