Your Path to College Readiness

The EDGE non-credit courses help you prepare for college and college-level work. Students will enroll in one of four EDGE Non-Credit courses. Choose a course where you need the most support and gain the skills to succeed in your college courses and beyond!



English EDGE (ENG-300)

Prepare for college-level reading and writing!
Learn essay-writing concepts and develop skills for academic success.



Student Development EDGE (COUN-300)

Gain an understanding of college expectations, support services, and resources to thrive at College of the Desert.



Statistics EDGE (SOC-300)

Learn and review statistical calculations, analysis, and interpretation for college-level statistics, ideal for students in majors requiring a statistics course.

- Health Science (Nursing)
- Social Science (Administration of Justice, Psychology, Political Science, History, Sociology)
- Kinesiology (PE teacher, personal fitness track)



Math EDGE (MATH-300)

Learn and review key math concepts to prepare for college-level math, ideal for students in majors requiring a math course.

- STEM (Architecture, Biology, Chemistry, Engineering, Math, Computer Science)
- Elementary School Teaching
